

CC 2.0 Introduction to Site Navigation

- 1. Log onto Cougar Courses. You are now at the **Site Home**. Check for any messages/updates in the Students section. If you do not see this section, contact <u>cchelp@csusm.edu</u> and ask that your account be added to the student role.
- 2. You will see your current semester courses listed under My Courses.
- You can also access your courses from the Navigation block. Click the triangle in front of My courses to expand the list. Then click the course name or click the triangle in front of the course title to access links to each topic/week of the course.
