

## **CC 2.0 Using Forums - Posting Content**


## Introduction

There are 4 different types of forums your Instructors can create.


- A standard forum, where any student can start a discussion or reply to any discussion.
- Each person starts (posts) one discussion.
- A Single Simple discussion You can only reply to the original post in this type of forum.
- Q & A forum You must post your reply to the original post before you will be able to see the other student's replies.

## Add a new discussion topic

- 1. Log onto Cougar Courses and go to the main page of your course.
- 2. Access the forum by selecting the forums link in the Activities block then clicking on the forum name, or by clicking the link from within the course content area.
- You will be taken to a new page that shows the forum instructions or prompt and the different active discussions (threads).
- To make a new post, click the Add a new discussion topic button.
- 5. Clicking this will create a new discussion topic which will be shown in the thread creation page.
  - Subject: enter in the title of your thread.
  - Message: type your message into the text box. You can use the text editing functions to format, add links, images, tables etc.
  - Subscription: This drop down lets you determine if you want to be emailed when/if someone replies to your thread.



Add a new discussion topic



- Attachment: if you need to include any files to the forum post, you can add them here
- Once happy with your post submission, click the **Post to forum** button. You will have 15 minutes to edit your post if necessary.
- 7. Your post will now be shown with the other active threads in your class forum.



## **Responding to Posts**

- 1. Log on to Cougar Courses, locate your classes' forum and select a discussion.
- 2. To reply to a post, click the **Reply** link at the bottom right-hand side of the post. Do not use the Add a Discussion topic button to respond to another student's post.



- 3. From the reply page, type your reply in the Message section.
- 4. Click **Post to forum**. Note: it's not necessary to change the subject when replying to a discussion.
- 5. If you wish to edit your post, you have 15 minutes to do so after you first create your reply.
- 6. Your response will be nested under the post that you replied to.
