

Submitting Multiple Drafts of a Turnitin Assignment

If your instructor has assigned a Turnitin Assignment requiring multiple drafts to be submitted, you will submit your first draft, receive feedback, and then later submit a second (possibly final) draft. Turnitin refers to these drafts as "Part 1," "Part 2," etc.

1. Click on your assignment from the course homepage or the Activities block.
