



# Submitting Multiple Drafts of a Turnitin Assignment

If your instructor has assigned a Turnitin Assignment requiring multiple drafts to be submitted, you will submit your first draft, receive feedback, and then later submit a second (possibly final) draft. Turnitin refers to these drafts as “Part 1,” “Part 2,” etc.


1. Click on your assignment from the course homepage or the Activities block.



2. Click on your **My Submission** tab.



3. Type in the title of your first draft.
4. Leave submission part set to **Part 1**.  
(*May have another title like “first draft.”*)
5. Click “Browse” to find and select your file.
6. Check the confirmation of your responsibility if this field appears (*optional for instructors*).
7. Click **Add Submission**.



8. If your draft submits successfully, you will see it listed with the time and date. Later, once your instructor has graded and made comments on your draft, you will click onto that assignment to view feedback. For guidance on reviewing feedback, see [How to View Your Graded Turnitin Paper](#).

9. Once it is time to submit your next draft, you will repeat steps 1 and 2.

10. From the drop down choose **Part 2** or other name that your instructor chose for the second draft.

*You must do this before entering the title of your draft.*

11. Type in the title of your second (possibly final) draft.  
 12. Click "Browse" to find and select your file.  
 13. Check the confirmation of your responsibility if this field appears (*optional for instructors*).  
 14. Click **Add Submission**.
