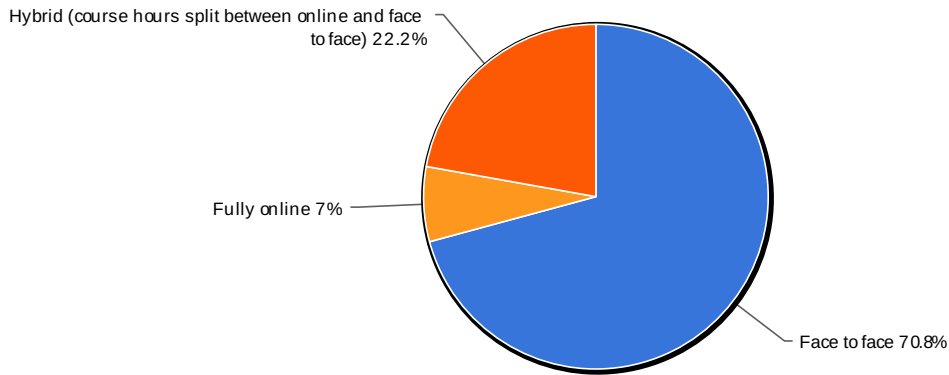

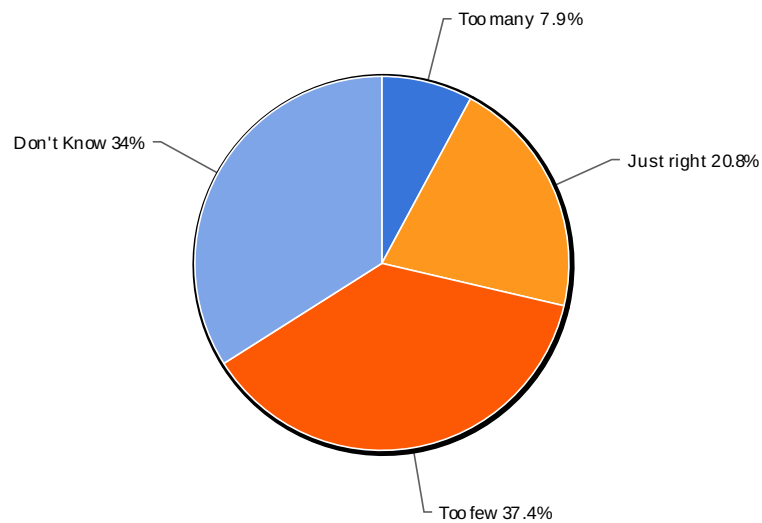
1. If you had the option to take a course you needed with your favorite professor, which format would you choose to take it:

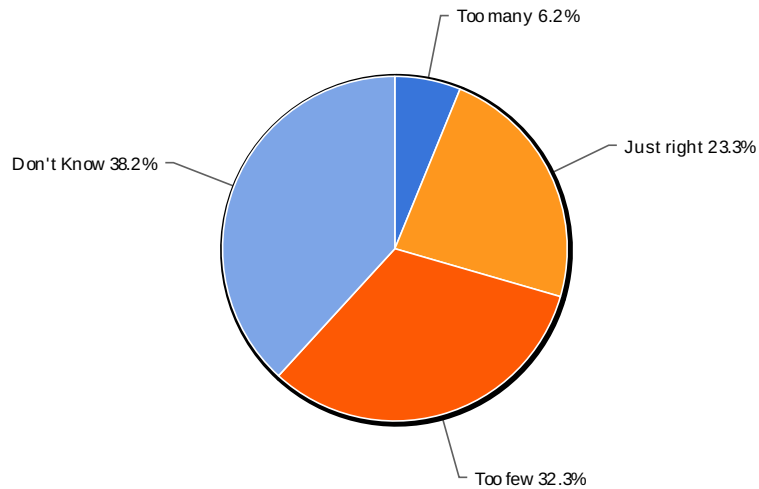

4. Do you think the number of hybrid courses (course hours are split between online and face to face) CSUSM offers is

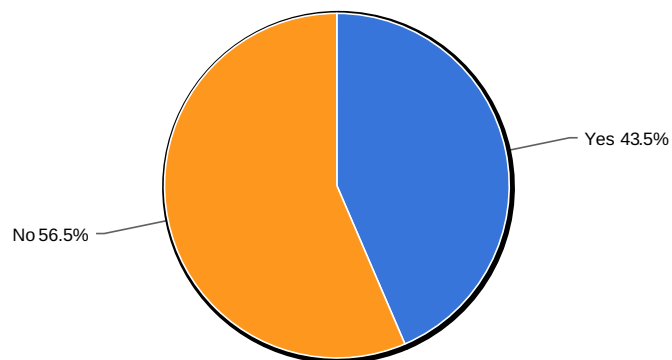

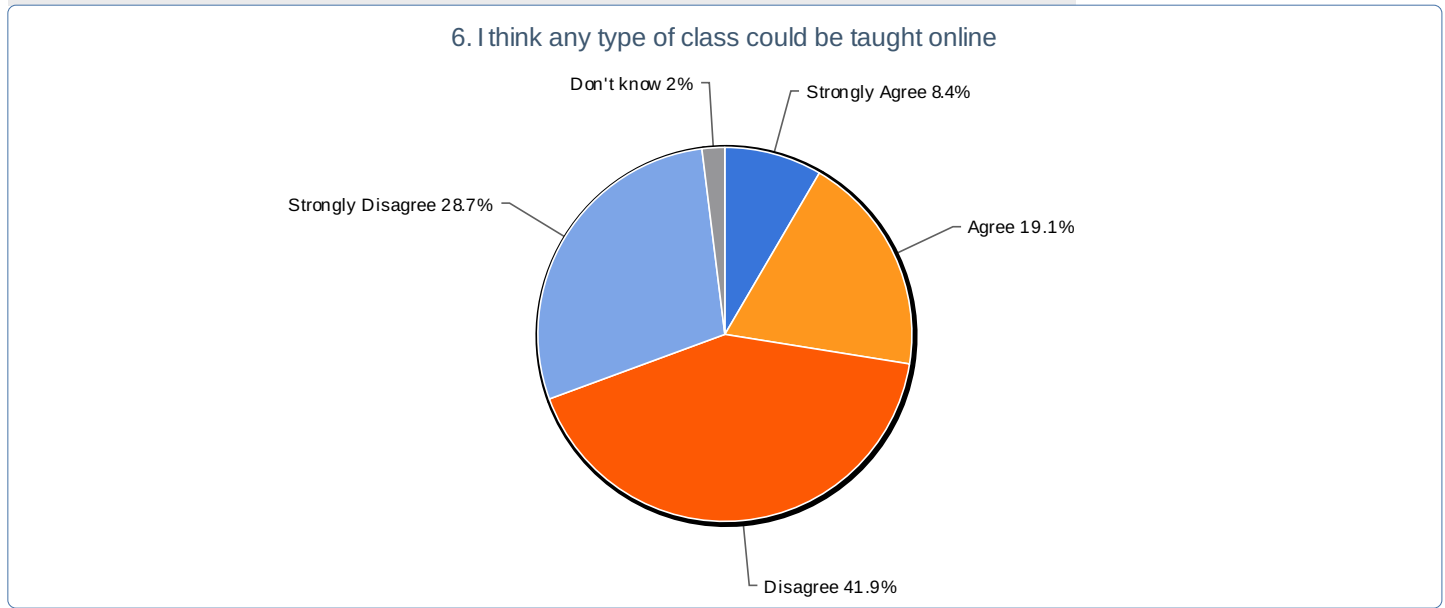
5. Have you ever had to take a fully online course because all face to face sections you wanted were full or not offered?

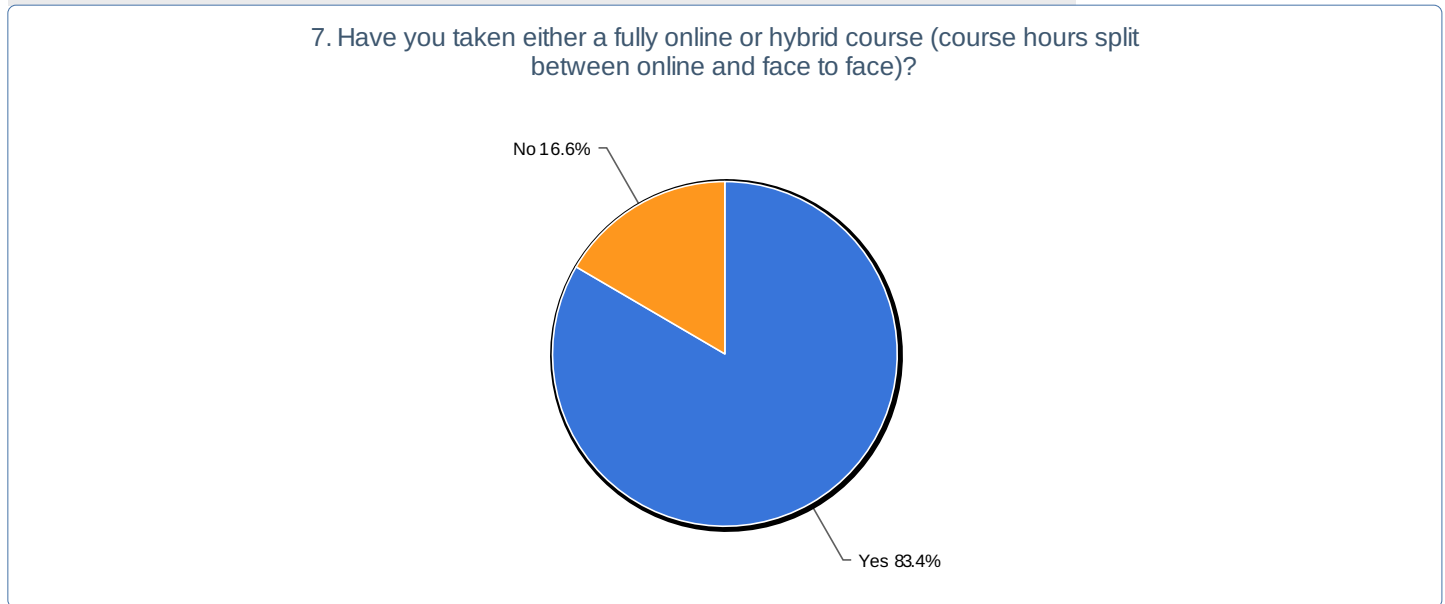

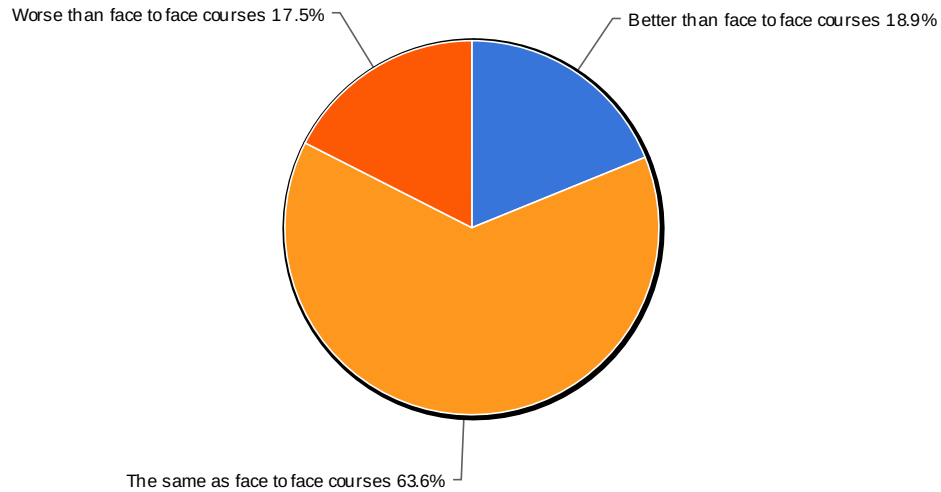

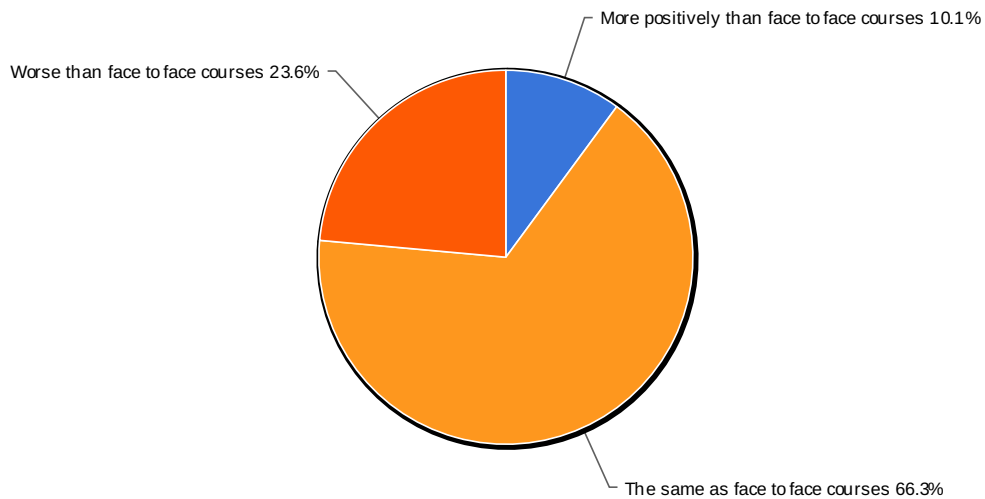

14. In an online course, I generally evaluate my professor

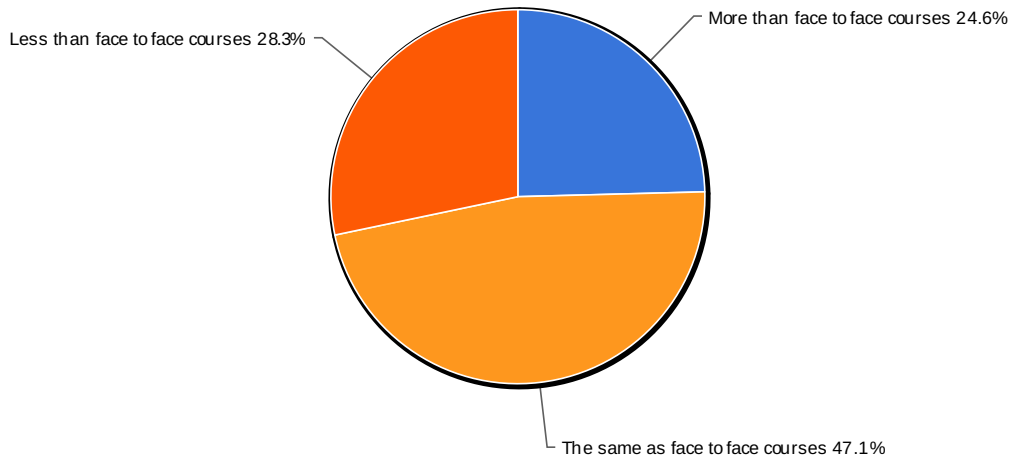

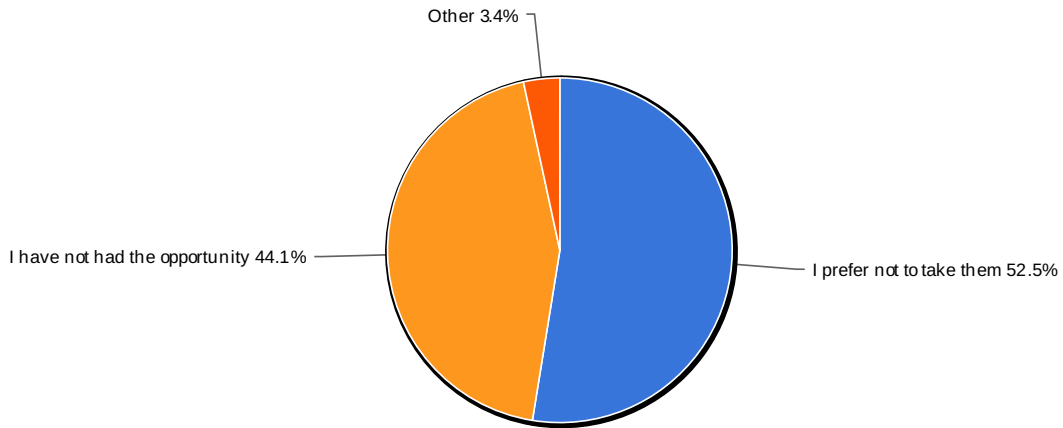

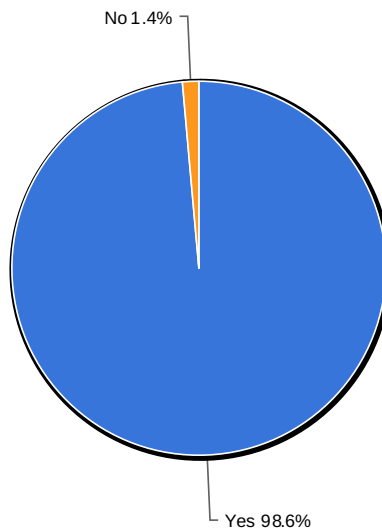

19. Do you own a computer, laptop, iPad, other tablet

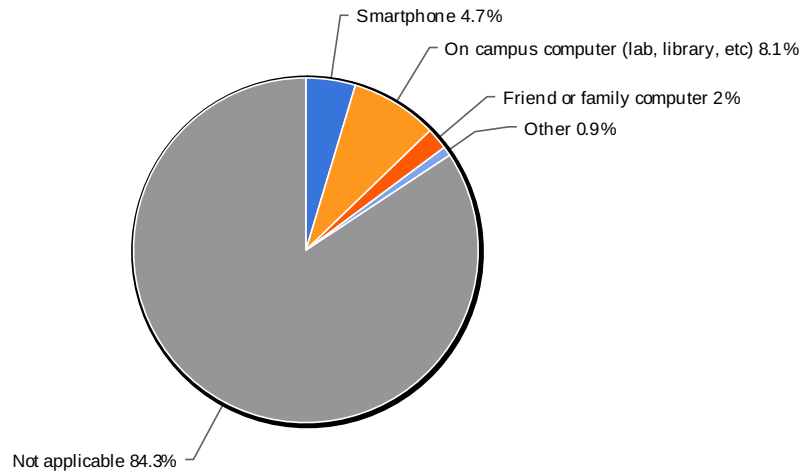

If you do not own a computer or tablet, how do you most often complete computer related course work?

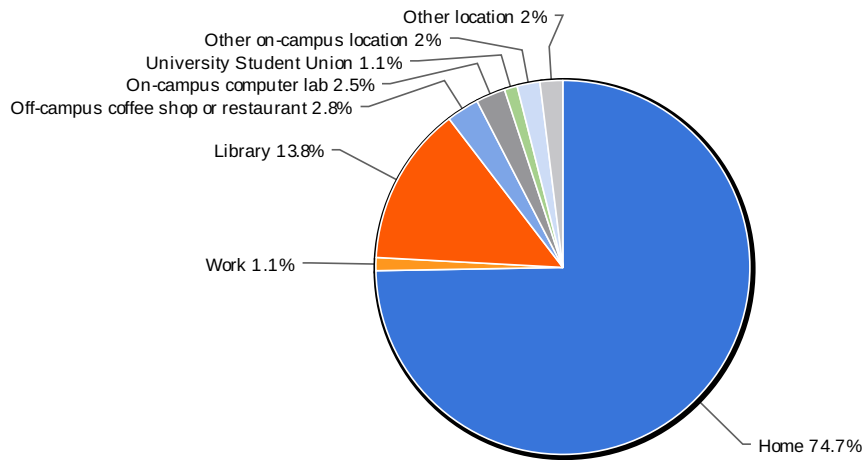

20. Where do you most often do your course work?

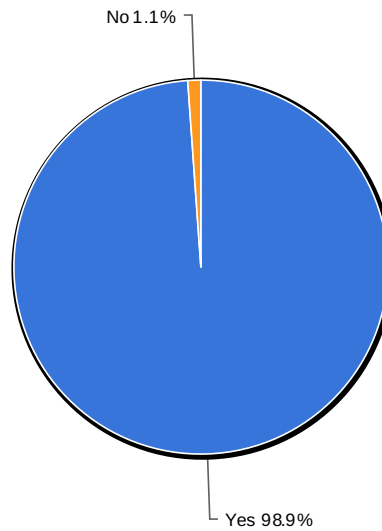

21. Do you have Internet at home?

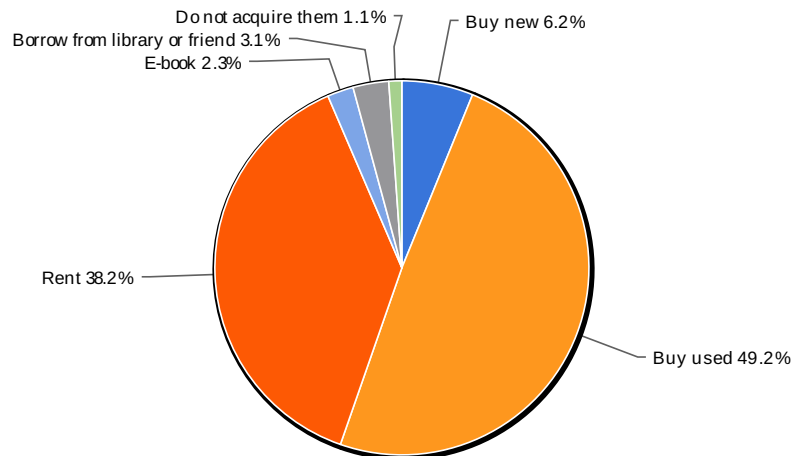

22. Which best describes the way you acquire textbooks for your courses



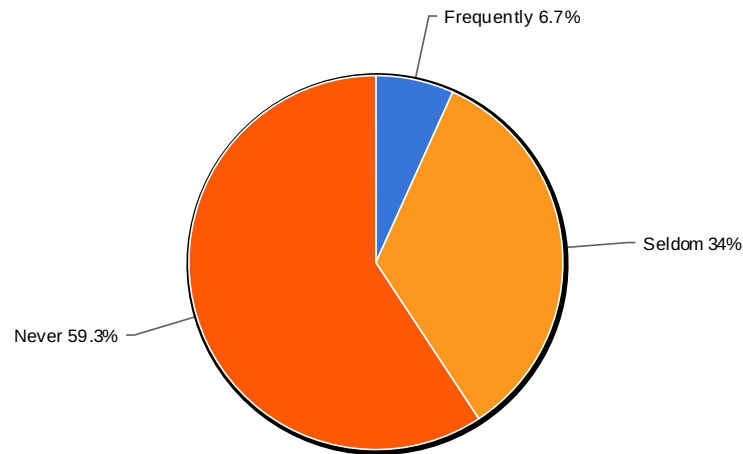

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23. How often do you borrow textbooks that are on course reserve at the library



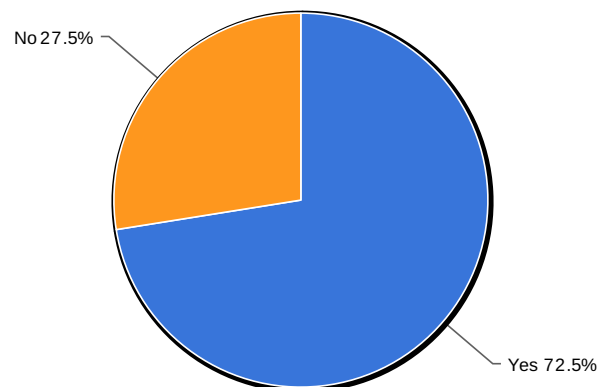

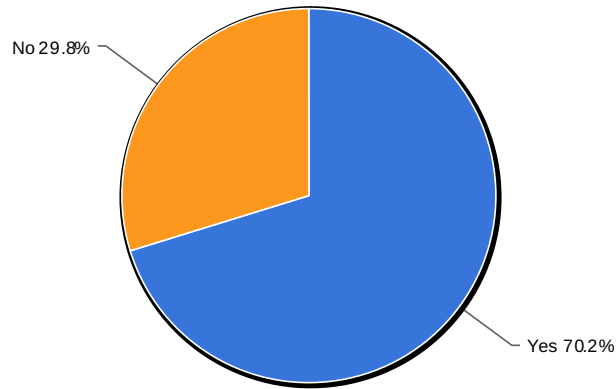

26. Do you currently receive financial aid?

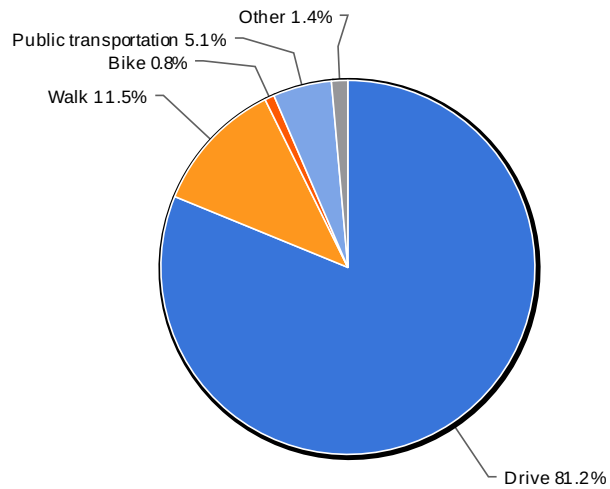

28. How do you most often travel to campus?

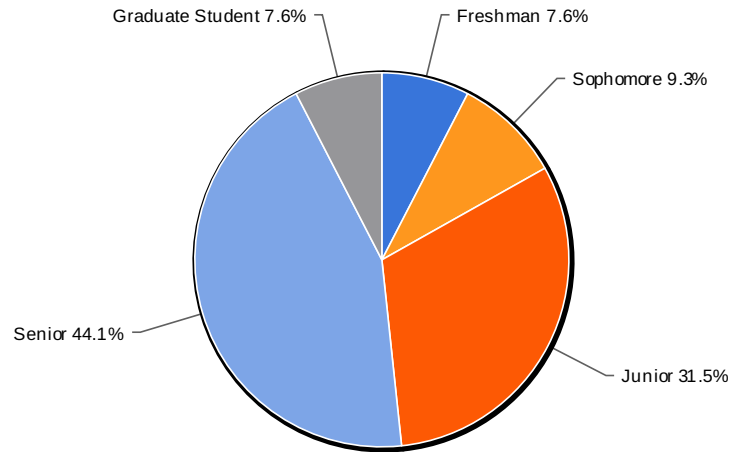

29. What best describes your year in college?

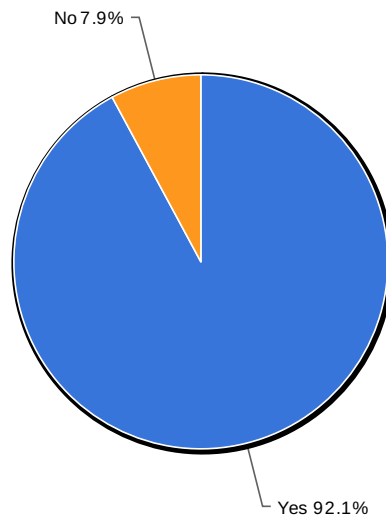

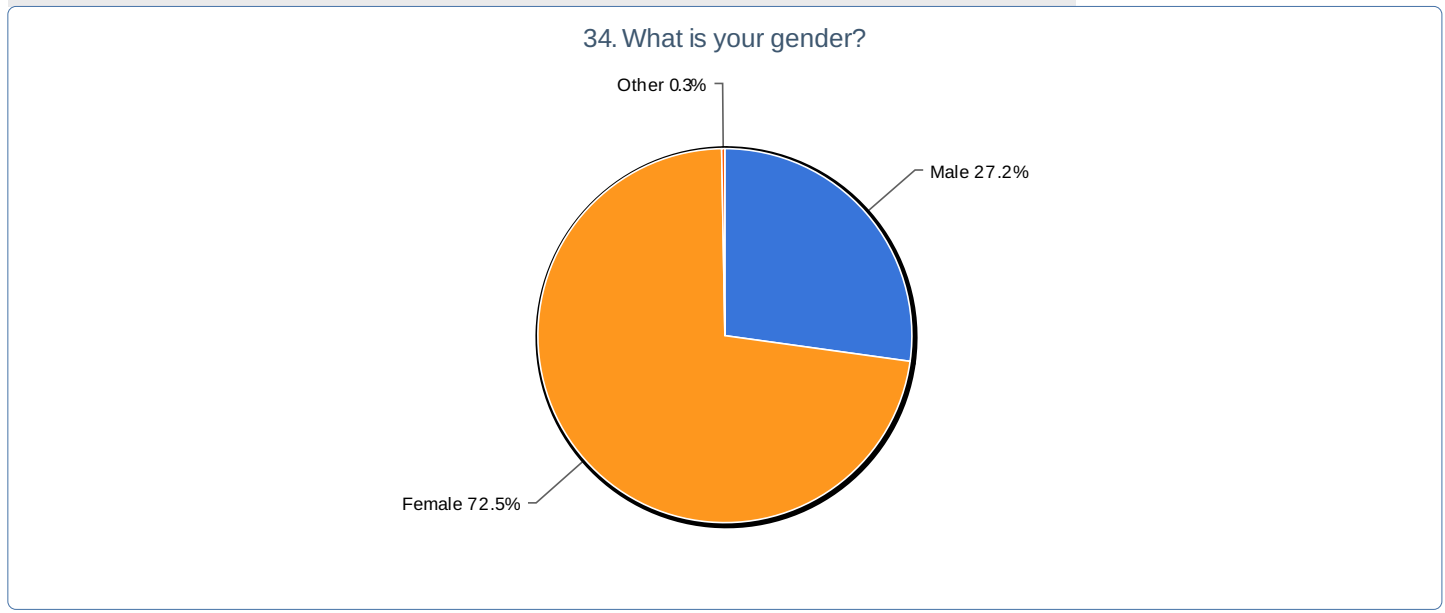
32. Are you a full time student?

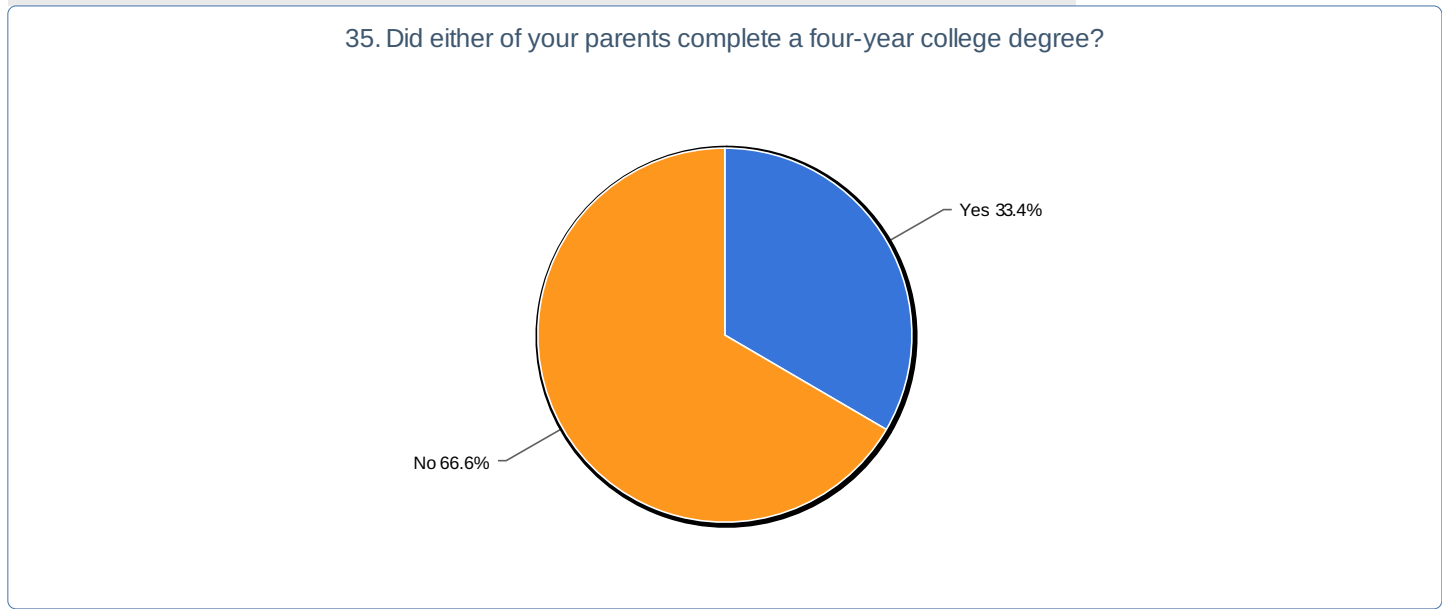

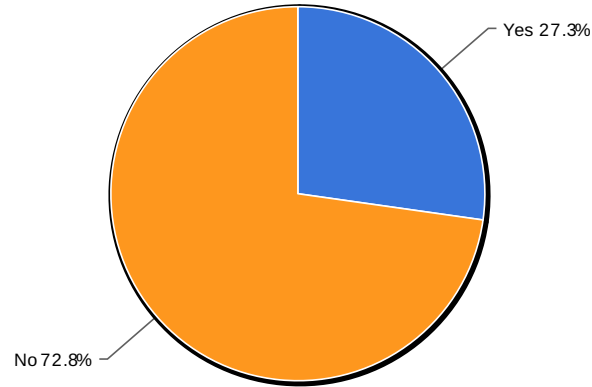


35. Did either of your parents complete a four-year college degree?

36. Are you a returning student?

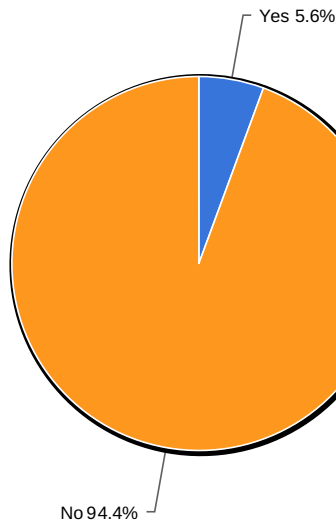

37. Are you a veteran?

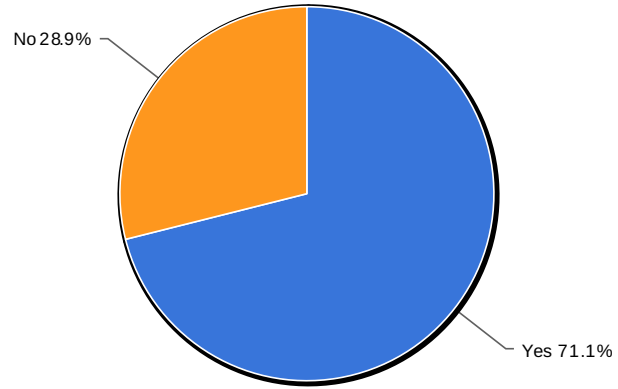
