

**Resolution on Satisfaction of the BB Requirement for Natural Science Majors**

RESOLVED, That a major in the natural sciences (Biological Sciences, Biotechnology<sup>1</sup>, Biochemistry, Chemistry, Computer Science, Mathematics, Applied Physics<sup>2</sup>) may satisfy the BB requirement as follows. He or she may take any upper division course offered by one of the departments in the natural sciences (Biological Sciences, Chemistry and Biochemistry, Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics) as long as the following hold: (1) the course is not offered by the department of the student's major, (2) the course is not cross-listed in the department of the student's major. This course may be used (and double count) toward the requirements of the student's major. Students should consult their academic advisors before choosing such a course. This measure shall take effect immediately and apply retroactively to all CSUSM students.

<sup>1</sup> For the purposes of this resolution, Biotechnology is to be viewed as belonging to the Biological Sciences department, so Biotechnology majors may not take any BIOL course to satisfy BB.
